- 7. What does Paul mean that he doesn't regard anyone from a worldly point of view? How do you tend to view people of this world?
- 8. Explain the concept of "reconciliation between God and people." Why would God give it to us? How do we accomplish this?
- 9. What do you think the Apostle Paul means when he says, "we are Christ's ambassadors"? Do you consider yourself as an ambassador for Christ? Why or why not?
- 10. How should the knowledge that we are His ambassadors guide how we live and interact with the world around us?
- 11. Reflecting on your life, where might God be calling you to be an ambassador for Jesus? How do you feel about that?
