1. Share about time where you have either been in the right place at the right time, or the wrong place at the wrong time.
2. Have you ever tried to make a bargain with God? If you remember, what was the bargain about? How did it turn out?
3. In Genesis 18, Abraham bargains with God about the city of Sodom. Why do you think Abraham was interested in saving a city that was so wicked?
4. What does God's willingness to spare the wicked cities for the sake of a few righteous people tell us about His character?
5. In what ways does Abraham's conversation with God about the fate of Sodom and Gomorrah shape your understanding of prayer and its power?
6. Read 2 Corinthians 5:16-21. What sticks out to you in this passage?
7. What does Paul mean that he doesn't regard anyone from a worldly point of view? How do you tend to view people of this world?
8. Explain the concept of "reconciliation between God and people." Why would God give it to us? How do we accomplish this?
9. What do you think the Apostle Paul means when he says, "we are Christ's ambassadors"? Do you consider yourself as an ambassador for Christ? Why or why not?
10. How should the knowledge that we are His ambassadors guide how we live and interact with the world around us?
11. Reflecting on your life, where might God be calling you to be an ambassador for Jesus? How do you feel about that?
